Final Assessment Roll will be available on Thursday, July 1st.

Receiver of Taxes

The last day to pay with a 1% penalty is Monday, March 1st. From March 2nd through March 31st, Town and County tax bills are due with a 2% penalty. The last day to pay your taxes is Wednesday, March 31st. After that date, you must call the Commissioner of Finance at 845-291-2480 for payment information.

We ask all residents who physically enter Town Hall to pay their taxes to instead utilize other options. You can mail in your payment, drop your payment into the secured drop box outside of the front entrance of town hall, or you can make your payment online by visiting the town website at www.townofmontgomery.com and click on the "Property Tax Bills" tab. If you have any questions related to paying your tax bill please call 845-457-2600 - extension 9, then press 1.
